Biologists plan and conduct biological investigations on wildlife and fishery resources as well as their habitat conditions to ensure high quality, defensible data for our Nation's decisionmakers.





Biologists gather, organize, and interpret a wide variety of biological, ecological, and other information. Duties include conducting field sampling, preparing samples, maintaining databases, performing data analyses, and communicating findings through reports and journal articles.

Qualifications based on education and experience vary for different grade levels. Requirements include a professional knowledge of biology and a working knowledge of related disciplines to conduct ecological investigations.
