Biological **T**echnicians perform many duties that add to the understanding of living organisms by assisting in the study of organisms, performing experiments, or working in biological sciences laboratories.





Biological Technicians perform many duties that add to the understanding of living organisms. They assist biologists in studying organisms, perform experiments, or work in biological sciences laboratories. They collect botanical, fisheries, wildlife, or other biological data and perform analyses to determine specified chemical, biological, or physical characteristics. They also work in the laboratory or field to assist in collection of data or analysis of biological samples.

Qualifications based on education and experience vary for different grade levels. Requirements include knowledge of biological sciences and routine field-data collection procedures to collect biological data and skill in using biological data-measuring instruments.
